

1. **KEEP CAMP SITE SIZES TO BARE MINIMUM.** There will be thousands of people camping and everyone needs a space.
2. **ONCE YOUR CAMPSITE IS SET UP KEEP ONLY 1 CAR FOR RUNNING BACK AND FORTH.** Please park all other vehicles in the parking lot. (Exception is those sleeping in their cars).
3. **NO CAMPING OUT OF BOUNDS.** Boundaries are signed. Anyone found camping out of bounds will be notified to move their camp site back in bounds. If in doubt contact a camp host and they will make sure you are in bounds.
4. **SOMETIME BETWEEN 9-10 AM SATURDAY THE COURSE WILL BE CLOSED AND THOSE CAMPED IN THE INFIELD WILL BE BLOCKED IN UNTIL SUNDAY AFTERNOON.** No exceptions.
5. **KEEP FIRE LANE CLEAR AT ALL TIMES.**
6. **DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.** RANGERS ARE ON SITE AND WILL BE TICKETING.
7. **RESPECT QUIET HOURS AND OTHER CAMPERS.** Many campers are solo, two-person, for-person teams and need to rest. Have fun but be neighborly.
8. **NO ON GROUND CAMPFIRES.** Fire pits are okay if you brought one but no fire on the ground. Above ground BBQ's are OK.
9. **DRIVE SLOWLY** There will be people walking and riding on the road. It also helps keep the dust down and the road in good shape.
10. **PICK UP YOUR TRASH.** There is a 30 yard dumpster just east of the finish line.
11. **BE PATIENT WITH VOLUNTEERS.** There is record attendance this year and the volunteers are doing the best they can to assure everyone has a good time.
12. **NO MOTORCYCLES AS PIT BIKES.**
13. **DO NOT TAKE DOWN OR MOVE COURSE OR CAUTION TAPE.**
14. **KEEP THE START/FINISH LINE CLEAR.** Please look before crossing the course. The last mile of the course is one of the fastest parts of the course and riders will be moving very fast.
